

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR AND TEACHER



The Joy of His Resurrection

"Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, for his mercy endures forever!"

Once again, we come to the beginning of Holy Week and prepare our hearts and spirits for the celebration of Easter. As we stand on the threshold of the observance of the last week of our Lord's earthly life, we are reminded of His suffering, sacrifice, and the reality of our sins. I want to suggest two important Biblical and historical facts about Easter. The first is the early believers, in the first century, celebrated Easter every Sunday, not just once a year. Second, frequently during the persecution of the first-century Christian church, their Easter celebrations had to be done secretly for fear of arrest, torture, and even death.

It was in the 4th century that a form of Christianity was legalized. As we worship in the beauty of our sanctuary during this holy season, we should not only remember the struggles of the founders of our faith but also our recent exile due to the global pandemic that caused us to spend two Easters outside of this sacred space. We rejoice in celebrating Palm Sunday together for the 20th time this Sunday. Over these years, we have experienced much joy and some sorrow, but we still rejoice in the goodness of God. We will celebrate communion at the Lord's table and receive palms blessed at the altar of the Lord as we begin to

experience the most challenging week
Jesus ever experienced. During this Holy
Week, we invite you to join us for the first
time in three years for our in-person
Maundy Thursday Service downstairs in
the social hall as we gather seated around
the cross of Christ. We will be blessed with
music from the choir, scripture reading
from our Deacons, and a re-enactment of
the acts of our Lord Jesus on that
Thursday night before his crucifixion.

On Good Friday, we invite you to join us for our Virtual Good Friday "Women at the Cross" Service on Zoom. I invite you to participate in this service from the comfort of your homes as we are led by Sisters in the Spirit in a moving experience of word and song. Our guest preacher for Good Friday will be Pastor Imani Jones, copastor of Advent UCC in Columbus, OH. Pastor Imani is no stranger to Mt. Zion. She and her husband, Pastor Colin Jones, have preached at Mt. Zion for our Scholarship/Family Day celebrations in years past.

We look forward to the great word that she will bring. As is our tradition here at Mt. Zion, there will be no meetings on Holy Saturday. We take that time to prepare ourselves for the high and Holy celebration of the resurrection of our Lord.

On Easter Sunday, we will come into God's house rejoicing in God's goodness and in the wonderful blessing of salvation that is ours because He got up. In this time, let us humble ourselves, pray, seek God's face, and turn from anything that is not pleasing to God. Let us continue to focus our attention on the journey of Jesus during the days before his crucifixion. By doing so, we will be ready to celebrate anew and, with great joy, the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ at Easter.

Sisters in the Spirit Celebrates Women's History Month

Women's History Month was celebrated at Mt. Zion with a weekend of events. On Saturday, March 11, Sisters in the Spirit hosted a virtual retreat with the Rev. Dr. Melbalenia Evans as guest preacher. The theme was *Women of God, Standing in the Gap, Bridging the Divide* with Esther 4:15-16 as the focus scripture.

Rev. Evans shared a powerful message and posed several questions that were discussed during a breakout room session. Questions such as the following were addressed, "Esther/Hadassah serves as an advocate for her people as she appears before the king. She literally risks her life for her people. During what time and in what circumstance have you desired, wished for, and needed an advocate to stand in the gap or bridge the divide for you?" The book of Esther does not mention God by name. Yet, in the midst of a potential crisis, Esther/Hadassah, calls for a fast. Before undertaking a life-threatening venture, she evidences an awareness of God's presence and interest in our lives. In what arenas of our lives do we move and function as if we are unaware of God and/or closet our faith? When is it expedient and advantageous to put God to the side?"

Feedback of the first breakout session was shared. Participants then moved into a second breakout session of their choice, either the Vision Board room or Prayer Journal room, led by Deacon Yvonne Dale and Rev. Dr. Cheryl Lindsay, respectively. Several guests who attended the retreat shared their enthusiasm of the day: "This retreat was awesome." "I really enjoyed the Prayer Journal group." I enjoyed both sessions." "Wow, this was amazing." "I enjoyed every part of this retreat and it was a treat for me although I was working. I was truly blessed." "The Prayer Journal session was outstanding." Rev. Cheryl Lindsay won a \$25 gift certificate with the most answers to the Icebreaker game, and Shilda Moore won a beautiful Mary Kay gift basket.

Following a spirit filled retreat, on Sunday, Mt. Zion was blessed with Deacon Robin Sadler as the Women's History Month speaker, along with a Women's History Month Choir led by Leesa Jackson. Deacon Sadler's sermon topic was "The Way God Sees You." Her three points were, 1. "You are not who people say you are. You are who God says you are," 2. "God's love for you is greater than your lack of love for yourself," and 3. No matter where you are or who you are today, you can still become the person God created you to be. The entire weekend was a blessing to God!


